### Topic: Conversation between Shopkeeper and Customer

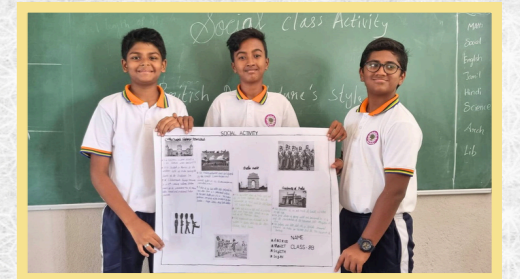

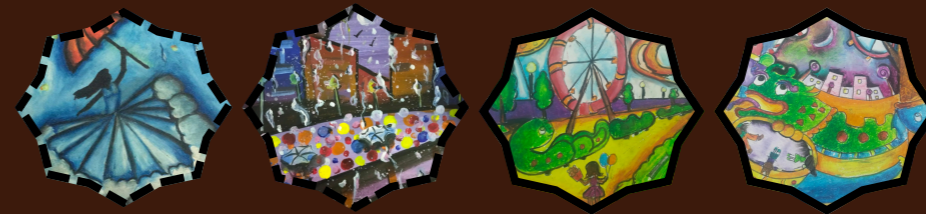
