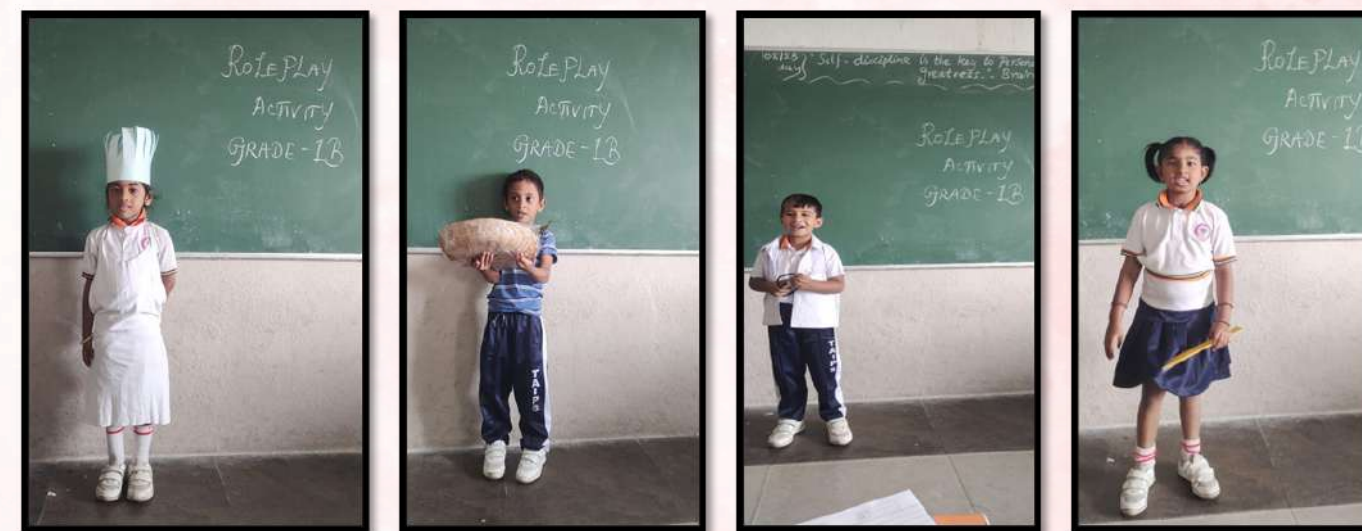
Vinayagar Chaturthi Celebrations

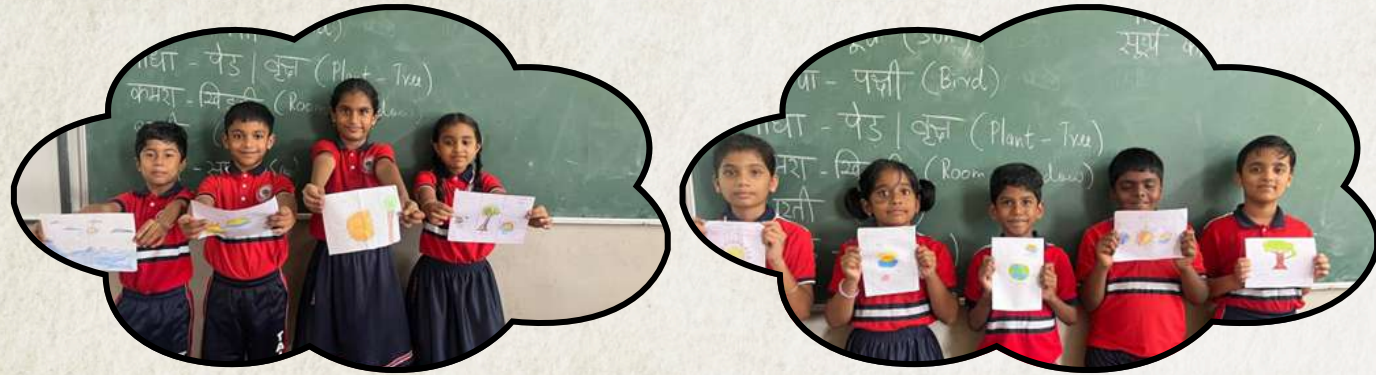


HINDI ACTIVITY

Topic: Constitution Tree - Fundamental Rights & Duties

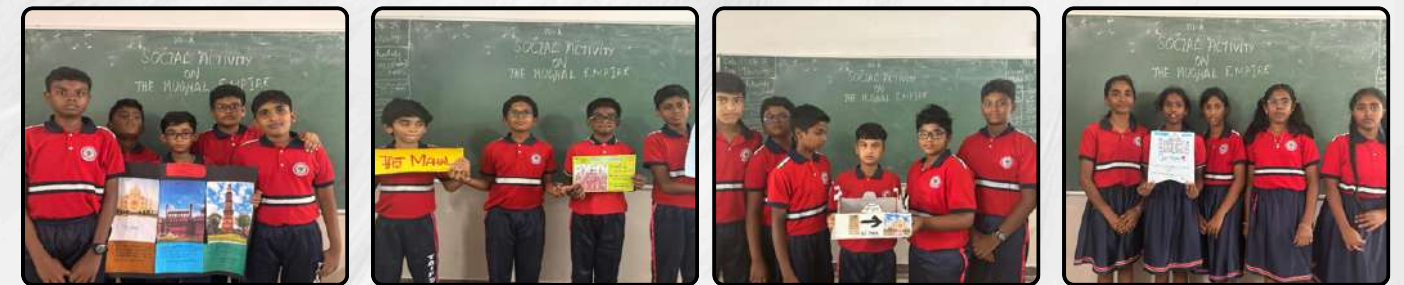

A hands-on experience that made **learning anatomy fun, visual, and memorable!**

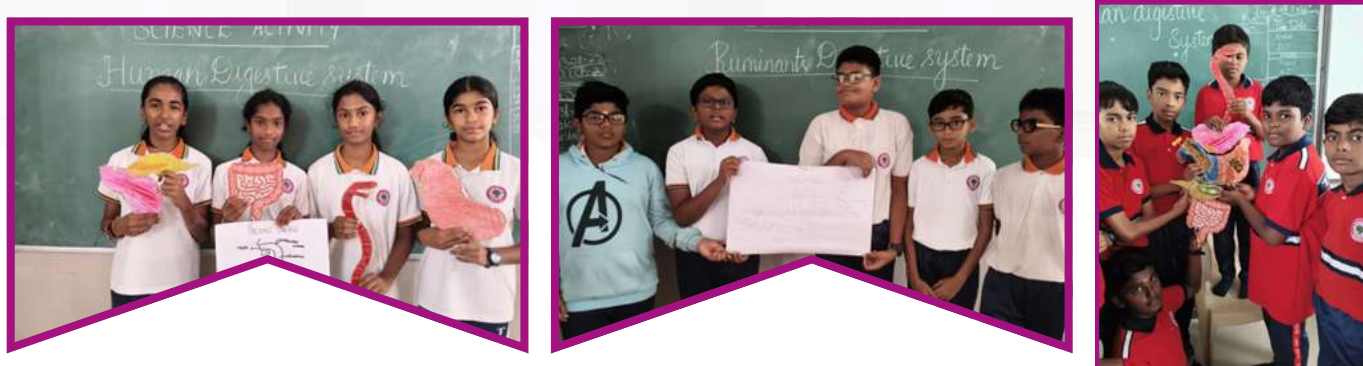


Science Class Activity – Grade 7

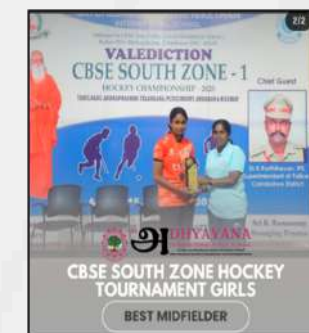

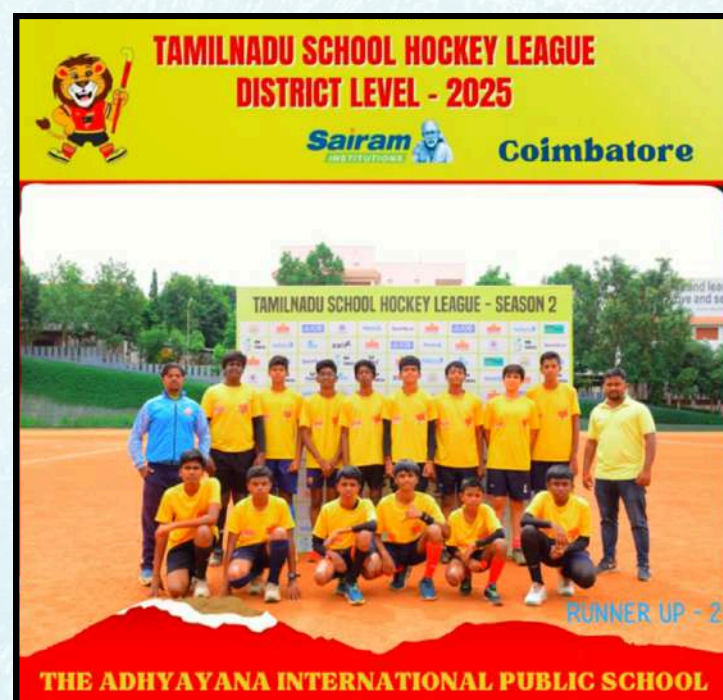
